In relation to cookies while browsing

The cookie (or computer cookie) is a small information sent by a website and stored in the user's browser, so that the website can consult the previous activity of the user.

_gat	Statistics	These cookies are installed by Google Universal Analytics to restrict the percentage of applications in order to limit data collection in high traffic areas.	1 minute
_gid	Statistics	This cookie is installed by Google Analytics. The cookie is used to aggregate information about how visitors use a website and helps create an analytical report on website performance. The data collected includes the number of visitors, the source of where they came from and the pages visited anonymously.	1 day
NID	Statistics	This cookie is used for a profile based on the interest of the user and show personalized ads to users.	6 months
